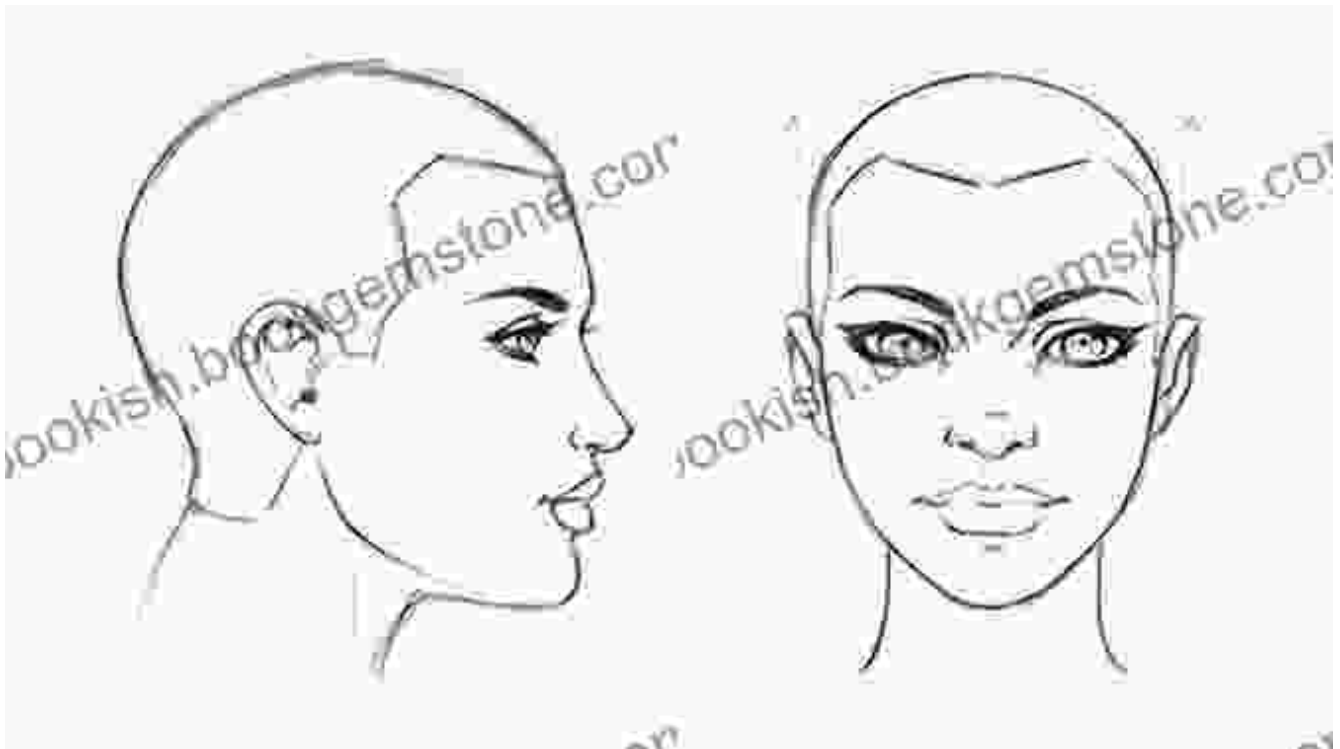

1. Sketch the Basic Head Shape

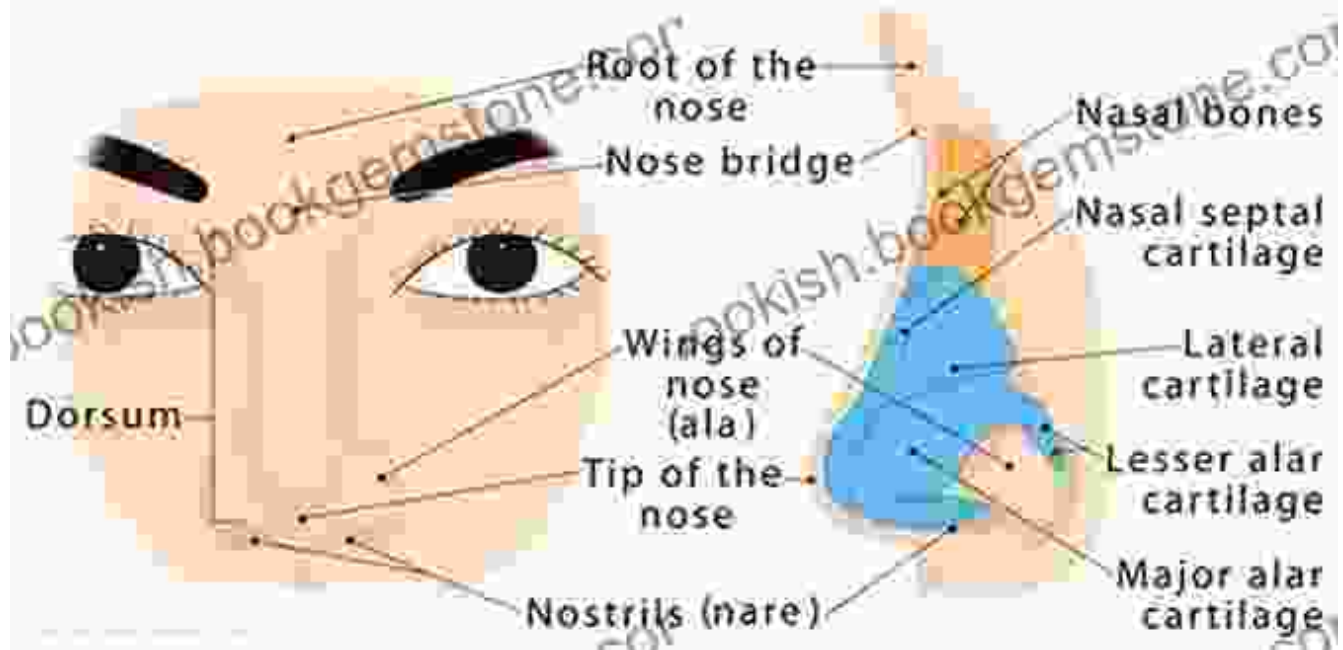
