
On the Beat: My Story


The Road Ahead



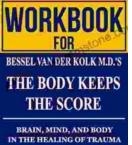
