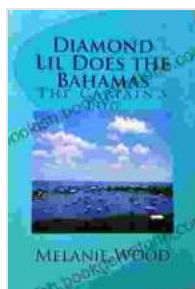


The Captain's Log: Diamond Lil

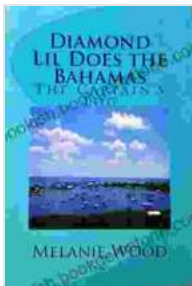

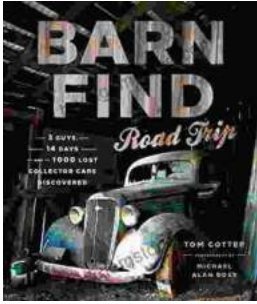

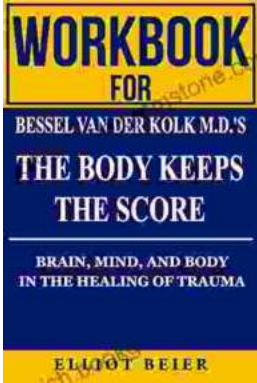
