If you are looking for an adventure of a lifetime, I highly recommend a flying boat tour of the Bahamas. It is an experience that you will never forget.

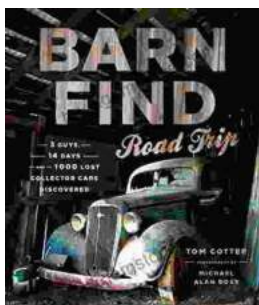


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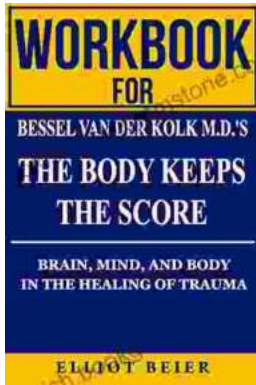
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
