




The next time you get into a taxi, take a moment to talk to the driver. You may be surprised at what you hear.

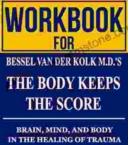
